Please contact your proposed major department for specific dates. Unless indicated otherwise, the application and \$55 nonrefundable fee must be postmarked by the deadlines below:

GRADUATE ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

Oregon State University offers admission to applicants whose records demonstrate the highest potential for graduate study and promise for substantial contribution to both their academic professions and to the diverse, global society. The university fosters an environment that welcomes inclusiveness.

Admission decisions are based on many factors, such as the quality of the applicant's prior academic degree and record of accomplishment, statement of purpose, letters of recommendation from professors or others familiar with the applicant's academic work, performance in aptitude and achievement tests, relevant work experience, preparation in the proposed field of study, and the connection of the applicant's academic goals with the faculty's research interests.

The following minimum requirements guide the university and its graduate programs in the consideration of applicants for graduate admission.

INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS

- The equivalent of a U.S. Baccalaureate degree of at least four years duration with a B average (equivalent 3.00 on a U.S. 4.00 grading scale) in the last two years, plus all subsequent graded course work, or
- A four-year equivalent baccalaureate degree with a two-year equivalent graduate degree.
- English language proficiency demonstrated by a minimum TOEFL score of 550 (paper) or 213 (computer), or 80 (internet) with subscores of 18 or above. A minimum score of 6.5 on the IELTS may be used as an alternative to the TOEFL test requirement. Scores must be no more than two years old at the time of the applicant's first term of registration.
- Documentation of sufficient financial resources to attend OSU as a graduate student including OSU's Certification of Finance Form.
- Minimum GPA for admission to only graduate certificate programs is set by the departments that supervise the certificates. Applicants requesting admission to only graduate certificate programs should contact their departments to learn more about minimum GPA and other requirements.

University conditional admission of international students presenting TOEFL scores of at least 500 (paper) or 173 (computer, or 61 (internet) may be granted if the application is otherwise fully admissible. Such conditional admission requires on-campus testing of English language proficiency prior to enrollment, and compliance with the specified plan for English and academic course work during each quarter until such time as the student qualifies for regular admission. Conditional admission based on English language proficiency requirement is waived for students who have received a bachelor's degree or advanced degree from a U.S. university. Conditional admission based on English language proficiency may not be granted to students seeking admission to only a graduate certificate program.

THE GRADUATE ADMISSION PROCESS

All graduate admission application materials should be sent in one packet to the Graduate School. The department you request as your major will examine the materials you submit to determine the adequacy of your scholastic background and decide whether departmental facilities are adequate for your expressed aims. A critical consideration in the decision is whether your academic objectives can be fulfilled satisfactorily by the OSU graduate program to which you are seeking admission. The department of your major will notify you if additional materials are required. In the case of Master of Arts in Interdisciplinary Studies (MAIS) applicants, three departments or programs, one for each field within your integration will examine your materials.

Supplemental information you provide as part of your application materials, such as letters of reference and your statement of purpose will greatly assist faculty in assessing both your preparation for graduate study and the academic program's ability to meet your stated goals. You are encouraged to give thoughtful attention to your choice of references and to your written statement of purpose.

If your baccalaureate degree was awarded by an institution that issues nongraded transcripts, admission will be considered with the support of your intended department's written evaluation attesting to the quality of your student transcript record.

If you do not meet the minimum requirements for graduate admission you may be considered with the support of your academic program, plus review and approval by the University Graduate Admissions Committee. If your overall GPA on the last two years of your baccalaureate is less than 3.00 on a 4.00 scale, you are encouraged to take the Graduate Record Examination (GRE). Your GRE score, in combination with your transcripts, letters of reference, and statement of purpose, may be used by the academic program as another predictor of your success in graduate study.

In an effort to ensure academic success, options are available for all students to improve English language proficiency, both written and oral. Prospective graduate students should be aware that the university is not able to accommodate all applicants who meet the minimum admission requirements.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

You must submit all your application materials at one time to the Graduate School. You are encouraged to contact your academic program(s) of interest to determine whether additional admission materials are required beyond those listed below. To assure prompt processing of your application, follow these instructions carefully.

International applicants seeking admission only to a graduate certificate program must provide items 1, 2, 3, 7 and 8 below to the Graduate School and contact the departments to determine what other departmental materials are required for admission to the graduate certificate program.

1. Original and one copies of the paper application form or one electronic version of the graduate application (no paper copy is needed). (MAIS applicants must submit an original and four copies of the paper application form.)
2. \$55 check or money order in U.S. dollars payable to Oregon State University for the nonrefundable application fee. If you apply electronically, this fee must be paid by VISA, MasterCard, or Discover Card.
3. Two photocopies of all transcripts (not grade slips or reports) of previous academic work, undergraduate and graduate. (MAIS applicants must submit six photocopies of all transcripts.) Transcripts showing the last two years of the first baccalaureate degree must be included. All graduate and postbaccalaureate transcripts must be included. A certified English translation must be included for academic transcripts in languages other than English. If you are admitted, an official transcript from the above institutions must be received by the Graduate School prior to your second term of registration for a graduate degree program and prior to the first term of registration for a graduate certificate program.
4. One copy of your statement of objectives and particular fields of interest (MAIS applicants must submit four copies of the statement of objectives. The statement of objectives should discuss the three areas of study you are proposing, how they fit together to lend themselves to interdisciplinary study, and the rationale justifying why an interdisciplinary degree is being sought, as opposed to a degree based in a single discipline. Also discuss how your proposed academic objectives will help you meet your career goals or other goals beyond earning the MAIS degree. The statement should be 750 - 1000 words.) If you are applying electronically, your statement of objectives will be forwarded to the departments (no paper copies are needed).
5. Three letters of professional reference are required of all students, addressed to the proposed major department/program. If you have a master's degree, you should include a letter from your former major professor. Reference letters should be written on official letterhead. (MAIS applicants must submit four copies of each of their three letters of professional reference.) Unless your proposed program specifies sending letters directly to them, you may submit them to the Graduate School as part of your application packet and they will be forwarded.
6. Certain departments/programs require the GRE of all applicants. Address inquiries regarding GRE requirements to your proposed academic program. MBA applicants must submit a GMAT test score.
7. Applicants must provide proof of English language proficiency by submitting a TOEFL or IELTS test score, unless exempt: Your official TOEFL or IELTS test score must be received by the Graduate School prior to the start of your first term of enrollment. ETS school code for OSU is 4586.
8. A completed OSU Certification of Finance Form with supporting documentation, demonstrating sufficient financial resources for the desired academic program (attached).
9. All MAIS applicant materials - application, statement, transcripts, and letters - should be sent directly to the Graduate School.

**Application materials for funding should be sent directly to the departments and programs.

ADDITIONAL INTERNATIONAL STUDENT INFORMATION

At the start of each quarter, International Student and Faculty Services holds a mandatory orientation program for international students new to Oregon State University. All entering students should plan to arrive at least 10 days before the term begins. Exact dates and other information will be sent to international students who have been admitted. YOUR ADMISSION STATUS

You may be admitted to the Graduate School under the following categories:

- Regular Graduate Student - a student who has been accepted by the university and by a major department/program to work toward an advanced degree.
- Conditionally Admitted Graduate Student - a student who has not met the formal admission requirements but whose accomplishments have convinced the University Graduate Admissions Committee and the proposed major department/program that he or she has potential for success as an advanced degree candidate. Refer to additional information under the "International Applicant" section of this document.
- Provisionally Admitted Graduate - a student who has met all university criteria for admission but not yet all of the additional requirements specific to the academic department/program.

Once you are admitted, you should be certain you understand your admission status. Official admission is granted by the "Letter of Admission" from the Graduate School and is effective only for the term specified in the letter. If you wish to postpone your enrollment and attend in a future term, please submit a written request to change your application. The application fee is effective for one academic year from the date of your initial application. Applicants for a different academic year will be required to submit a new application form. New academic years begin with summer term.
